Domain Alfred, Pinot, Goss '06 **\$36/\$26**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$9.00

Goss Creek pinot noir is made with the same great fruit and care and style that the Estate and Califa wines are noted for. It fills the glass with the same pleasing cherry cola, sarsaparilla and “Chamisal spice” aromas and flavors that have made DA pinot a crowd favorite. Impeccable balance of fruit, oak, acid and soft tannins that make it friendly and accessible.

Labyrinth, Pinot, BN '06 **\$42/\$32**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$10.50

More nuanced and less rich than the 2005, with pleasant traces of graphite that compliments the red fruits and warm oak essence. Moderate alcohol makes this a most pleasant and balanced wine. Buy a case and stash it in a dark and forgotten place.

Margerum, Rhone Blend M5 '06 **\$38/\$28**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$9.50

M5 is a Margerum blend using five grape varieties from twelve different highest quality vineyards in Santa Barbara County vineyards to make one wine. As always, this multi-vineyard, multi-varietal cuvee illustrates the benefits inherent in a blended wine.

Woodstock, Sangiovese '04 **\$31/\$21**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$8.00

This classic Italian varietal is perfect for any cool weather meal with a strong backbone and spicy fruit flavors. Tones of cranberries, cherries and cassis are immediately noticeable while softer raspberry and cinnamon notes round out this fun wine.

Toucan, Cuvee '06 **\$36/\$26**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$9.00

A beautiful deep ruby color; forward black cherry and brambly fruit, vanilla toast, and a bit of spice on the nose; tastes of black raspberry/cherry, and earthy notes. A very balanced wine offering a lush full-mouth feel and complexity. Sixteen months in fine oak barrels has mellowed this wine nicely.

Kuyam, Petite Syrah '06 **\$38/\$28**

Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$9.50

90% Petite Syrah, 6% Syrah and 4% Cabernet Franc from the Santa Barbara Highlands - with yields of one to four tons per acre. Aged eleven months in barrels and eight months in the bottle. Only 88 cases produced. Trust me, this is a GREAT Petite Syrah.

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ABC Hildegard '04 Pinot Gris **\$45/\$35**
Taste: \$3.25 • Glass: \$11.50

This is a unique, textural, and complex wine with hints of lavender, marzipan, violets, and white chocolate aromas. A blend of Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc and Aligote. A great food wine

Lane Tanner, Julia's Pinot **\$49/\$39**
Taste: \$3.75 • Glass: \$12.25

This wine satisfies lovers of Burgundy with its' powerful fruit, satin texture and hints of mushrooms and earth. The Robb Report says this Pinot achieves what few Pinot Noirs do: Marrying the forceful fruit of California with the more delicate mold, mushroom and earth essences of grand crus of Burgundy.

ABC, Pinot, Isabelle '06 **\$60/\$50**
Taste: \$4.50 • Glass: \$14.50

Named after Jim Clendenen's daughter. This wine is a CELLAR SELECTION of the best barrels of single vineyard Pinot Noirs in the Au Bon Climat cellar from that vintage. This is Jim's premiere Pinot.

Arcadian, Pinot Fiddlestix '04 **\$65/\$55**
Taste: \$5.00 • Glass: \$15.50

Medium red. Blackberry and cherry scents are deepened by candied licorice and smoky minerals. Dense and chewy, offering sweet cherry and dark berry preserve flavors, with chewy tannins adding grip. A concentrated, somewhat brooding pinot that gained sweetness and energy with air, as well as suave spiciness.

Arcadian, Syrah Gary's '00 **\$57/\$47**
Taste: \$4.50 • Glass: \$14.50

This is from the personal library of Joe Davis, Arcadian's Owner and Winegrower. It is showing the beautiful bottle bouquet that only well-aged Syrah can obtain. This wine shows Arcadian's old world style, which allows the vineyard characteristics to show through. Garys' Vineyard is known for its amazing fruit, it's the source for many pricey and collectible wines.

Margerum, Syrah Uber '05 **\$60/\$50**
Taste: \$4.50 • Glass: \$14.50

2005 was an exceptional year as the fruit maturity and flavors were present early; this allowed for judicious selections at harvest priors to excessive sugar ripeness. This wine is aged for 20 months in mostly new barrels from a high quality producer in St. Romain, France.

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
